9. Amendments & Termination


- Any amendment to this MoU shall be made in writing and signed by both Parties.



The MOU may be terminated at any time by mutual written consent or by nine months' notice in writing by either of the two parties with due regard to the contractual commitments in terms of specific contracts.





9. Amendments & Termination


- Any amendment to this MoU shall be made in writing and signed by both Parties.


